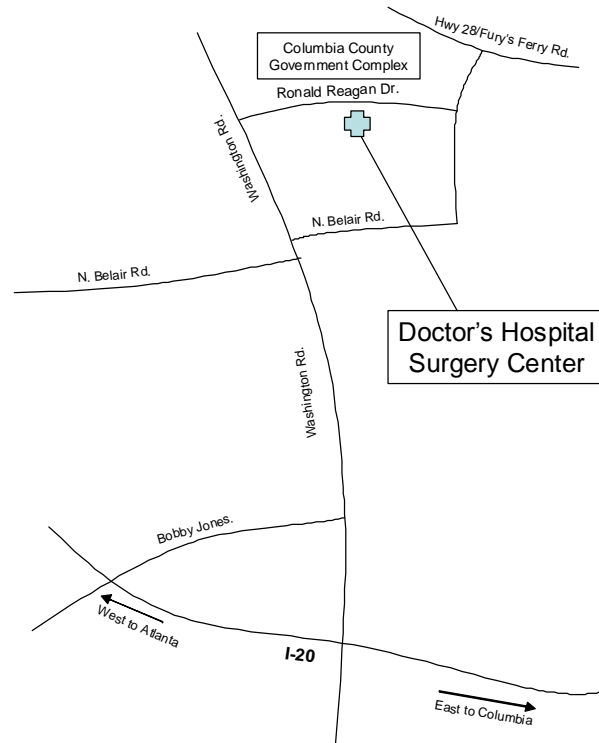


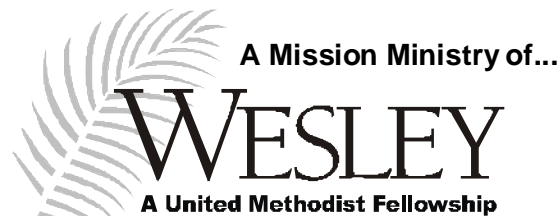
WHAT IS FAITHCARE CLINIC, Inc?

- FaithCare Clinic, Inc. is a free medical ministry of Wesley United Methodist Church, Evans, GA, serving people in Columbia County.
- Faithcare Clinic, Inc., is not an attempt to compete with other medical facilities or physicians, all of which may have resources and testing capabilities that FaithCare Clinic, Inc., does not have.
- We treat acute minor illness and provide primary health care services for the uninsured with no access to traditional medical care.
- Our clinic is staffed with certified and licensed volunteer doctors and nurses
- Some pharmaceutical assistance is available, although no narcotics or controlled substances are prescribed
